

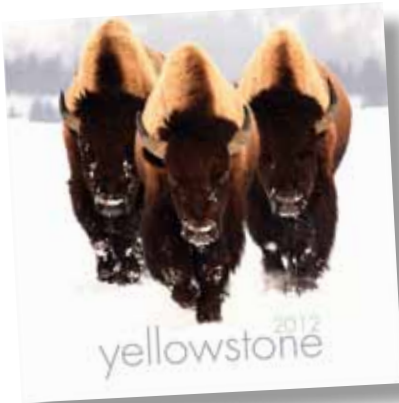

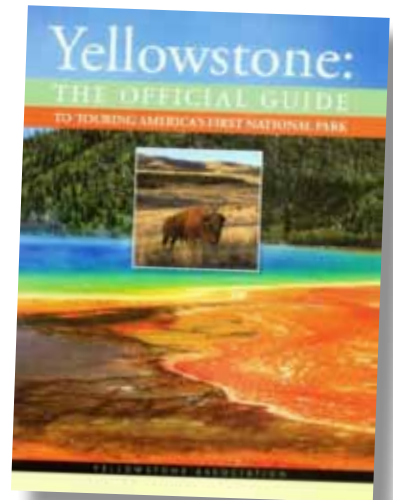

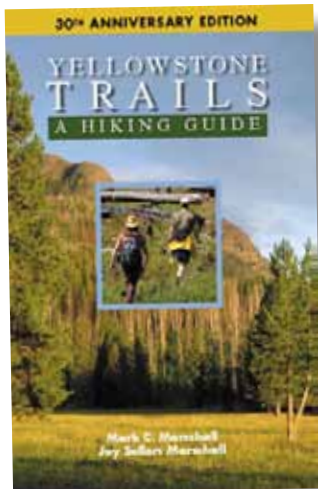


YELLOWSTONE TRAILS: A HIKING GUIDE

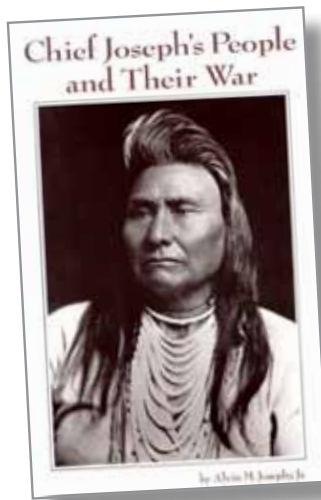

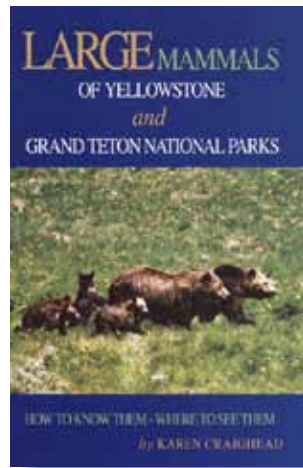

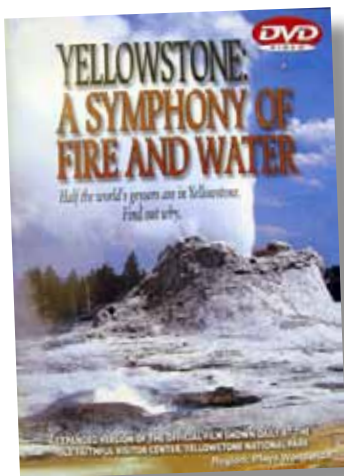

YELLOWSTONE: A SYMPHONY OF FIRE AND WATER

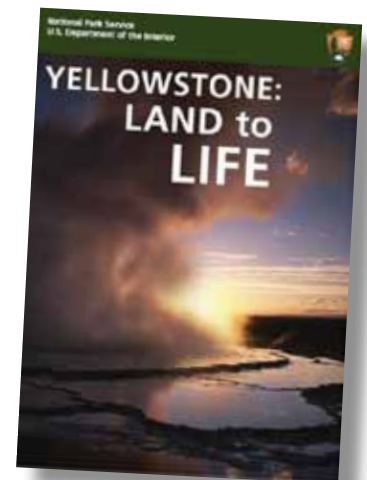
